

Parking Zones



General

What is a Parking Zone?

A Parking Zone is an area, where all parking will be controlled using mainly two different types of parking bay: **resident bays** and **limited waiting bays**.

There will be no uncontrolled parking at all, between 8am and 6pm.

No changes will be made to existing disabled bays as part of this process.

What are the types of parking bay?

Resident Parking Bays

- For resident permit holders only.
- No time limit on duration of stay.
- Operational hours: 8am to 10pm, every day of the week.

Limited Waiting Parking Bays

- You can stay for a maximum of 2 hours unless you have a resident parking permit.
- Operational hours: 8am to 6pm, every day of the week.
- A resident with a permit can park in a Limited Waiting bay for as long as they like.

Pay and Stay Parking Bays

- Bays where you pay for parking and you can stay for longer periods of time.

Resident Permits

I am a resident... How much do the permits cost?

The first permit for the first car from a household costs £7.50.

The second permit for the second car from a household costs £30.

I am a resident with a permit... Where can I park?

A resident with a permit can park in:

- A resident parking bay anywhere within the correct zone (24hrs, no time limit)
- A limited waiting bay anywhere within the correct zone (24hrs, no time limit)
- Pay and Stay Parking Spaces within the correct zone (24hrs, no time limit)

You can park where the signs say you can.

*only residents with a permit can park 24hrs within the above spaces, all others are subject to the restrictions noted on the signs.

Other

Business & Community Permits

Businesses will be able to obtain up to two permits to park for as long as they like in the limited waiting bays within their zone. These permits will initially be at no charge, however in due course these will be charged according to how polluting a vehicle is - [Cardiff.gov.uk/parking](https://www.cardiff.gov.uk/parking).

Churches and other properties exempt from paying business rates may obtain up to two community permits to park for as long as they like in limited waiting bays within their correct zone. Whilst these will be at no charge initially these will be charged at £10 per year in due course.

Permit holders will be advised when charges are due to be implemented.
